Admission Guidelines 2021-22

Indore School of Social work established in 1951, is one of the premier Institutes in Central India imparting training in Social Work leading to the Master of Social Work (MSW) degree of Devi Ahilya Vishwa Vidyalaya (DAVV), Indore. The college also offers Post Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Development (PGDHRD), Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) and Bachelor of Arts (BA).

Indore School of Social Work is exempted from online admission process by Department of Higher Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh due to its minority status and the candidates interested in any of the above mentioned courses can apply directly to the college for admission. The online admission form will be made available in our website (<http://isswindore.org>) after the dates are declared by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh (Tentatively in the month of July 2021).

College also follows the offline mode of admission where students can visit the college office on all working days from 10.30 am to 5.00 pm and obtain the application form and prospectus by paying the prescribed fees.

Admission Procedure

- Written Test conducted online or offline mode (For Admission to MSW Programme)
- Issue of Admission offer letter to the candidates who pass the entrance examination
- Document verification by the office
- Meeting with Principal (Offline or online)
- Payment of the first Installment of fees
- Confirmation of admission by registering the student details in the portal of Madhya Pradesh Government.

Hostel accommodation for boys are available in the campus and it will be allocated on first come first served basis. We have no hostel facilities for girls in the campus. They can be assisted in finding suitable accommodation in private hostels available in and around the institute.

MSW (Master of Social Work)	Bachelor's degree in any subject from UGC recognized University with minimum 45% marks.	Relaxation in percentage of marks for SC/ST/OBC students as per government norms. There is no age limit for applying to any of the Course.
PGDHRD (PG Diploma in Human Resource Development)	Bachelor's degree in any subject from UGC recognized University with minimum 45% marks.	
BSW (Bachelor of Social Work)	Students who have passed 12th standard from any Board are eligible to apply for BSW Course	
BA (Bachelor of Arts) Economics, Political Science, History and Sociology	Students who have passed 12th standard from any Board are eligible to apply for BSW Course

Documents to be submitted along with application form:

1. Copy of marks obtained at the High School, Higher Secondary and Bachelor degree examination (For MSW and PGD-HRD students)
2. Copy of the marks obtained at High School and Higher Secondary examination (For BSW and BA Students)
3. Copy of degree certificate/provisional certificate (For MSW and PGD-HRD students)
4. Original Transfer Certificate from the School or College last attended
5. Migration Certificate in original (for candidates from a University other than Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya).

Note: Students whose result of 12th (Higher Secondary) and Final Year Graduation Examination is awaited are also encouraged to apply but they require to produce the required documents within the prescribed time at the College. They will be given admission on a Provisional Basis. They can attach the documents of the latest examinations cleared by them.
